QUESTIONS:

- What does this passage SAY about how we should live?
 - What verse is God highlighting to you? What is He saying?
 - What is the main point of this passage?
 - What does this say about God? About you?
- What do you need to OBEY?
 - What is the one thing God is speaking to you to do this week?
 - What needs to change this week for you to obey?
- Who do you need to SHARE this message with this week?

DISCOVERING CHRIST AND THE GOSPEL IN SCRIPTURE:

- How is Christ our example to follow? (He shows us how)
 - Is there something or someone described that reminds you of the person or work of Jesus and stands as an example of Him in which you should follow?
- How has Christ fulfilled where we fail? (He does what we cannot)
 - Are there roles, relationships, or characteristics in the Bible that are ruined by sin, wickedness, or mistakes? Jesus fulfills every single promise and does perfect every command of the Law.
- How does Christ make atonement for our sin? (He takes our place)
 - Do you see ways in which Christ actually takes the undesirable position or punishment even though He did no wrong? In order to do this properly, you have to be able to see yourself as the one deserving of judgment.
- How does Christ give us His power to walk in? (He gives us His power)
 - Can you see how Christ gives us His power as He invites us to partner with Him in ministry?
