Hygiene Policy



HAND WASHING

- Volunteers are to wash hands after:
 - 1. Using the bathroom (or helping a child use the bathroom)
 - 2. Changing a diaper
 - 3. Wiping or blowing their nose (or helping a child wipe or blow his/her nose)
 - 4. Handling items soiled with any body fluids or wastes (including drool, urine, stool or vomit)
 - 5. Handling or caring for a sick child
 - 6. Before and after eating/drinking
 - 7. Before serving snacks
 - 8. Before administering first aid
 - 9. When changing rooms or caring for a different group of children.
- Children wash their hands, use wipes, or use hand sanitizer after each restroom visit and before snacks are served.

TOY DISINFECTANT

 Nursery toys are removed from play after each use until they can be wiped with an anti-bacterial disinfectant.
